

Have you ever watched a child's face light up on Christmas morning? Their eyes go wide, and everything feels like pure magic. That's the wonder we want to recapture this December with our sermon series: "Christmas Through the Eyes of a Child."

Week 1: When Everything Feels Like Magic (December 7)

Remember when Christmas felt absolutely magical? That's how the shepherds felt when the sky exploded with angels. That's how Mary felt when Gabriel told her she'd have God's baby.

But we've heard these stories so many times they can start to feel ordinary. This week, we're asking God to give us fresh eves—to help us see the Christmas story like we're hearing it for the very first time. Because God becoming a baby should never feel boring.

Week 2: The Best Kind of Waiting (December 14)

Kids are the best at anticipation. They count down the days and can barely sleep on Christmas Eve.

God's people waited 400 years for Jesus. Simeon and Anna waited their entire lives to see the Messiah. But they didn't wait with dread—they waited with hope, believing God would keep His promises.

This Sunday, we'll talk about waiting well—not just for Christmas Day, but for Jesus to come back. Watching with hope instead of anxiety.

Week 3: Seeing What Jesus Sees (December 21)

Jesus, who created the universe, chose to experience it as a helpless baby.

Think about what baby Jesus saw—a feeding trough instead of a crib, barn animals, poor parents far from home. He felt cold and hunger. The God who made eyes was now seeing through human eyes for the first time. He saw our messy, broken, beautiful world—and chose it anyway. Because of Christmas, we know God understands exactly what we're going through.


Week 4: Trusting Like a Kid (December 28)
