We've been walking through the book of Exodus together in our When God Shows Up series. Along the way, we've watched God meet people in unexpected places, hear the cries of His people, and remain faithful to His promises. Now we come to Movement 5: He Delivers.

Jimmy Maupin kicked off this section on August 30 with a great message, "He Reveals His Name," from Exodus 3. We saw how God met Moses at the burning bush and called him by name. God knew Moses' story. He knew where Moses had been, and He knew where He was going. And the same God who called Moses still knows you by name today.

Over the next several weeks, we'll continue following Israel's journey and see what happens when God shows up to deliver His people.

Through the plagues, God showed Pharaoh that his power wasn't ultimate. Egypt's gods weren't ultimate. The Lord is. At Passover, the blood of a lamb protected God's people, pointing us forward to Jesus, our Passover Lamb, who delivers us from sin.

Then Israel finds itself trapped, with the sea in front of them and Pharaoh's army behind them. There seems to be no way forward—until God opens the sea and leads His people through on dry ground. Sometimes God doesn't remove the obstacle; He makes a way through it. When we can't see a way, God can.

On the other side, Israel sings. They don't know what tomorrow will bring, but they know what God has already done. Worship isn't just for the easy days. It's our response to God's faithfulness.

And the story doesn't end with Israel escaping Egypt. God's goal was never simply to get His people out of Egypt. He wanted to bring them into His presence. Exodus tells us that God would dwell among His people. Centuries later, John tells us that in Jesus, God came to dwell among us.

Through Jesus, God still says, "I am with you always."

When God shows up, He delivers.
