Love is one of the most talked-about topics in our culture—and one of the most misunderstood. We hear about love in songs, see it portrayed in movies, and read about it in books. But what does it really mean to love the way Jesus calls us to love?

This February, we're diving into a four-week sermon series called "Learning to Love Like Jesus." Together, we'll explore what it means to love God, ourselves, one another, and even the people who challenge us most. This isn't just a series about feeling warm emotions or being nice to people. It's about discovering a transformative kind of love that changes everything—starting with our own hearts.

**Week 1: Learning to Love God (February 1)**

We'll begin where love itself begins: with God. Drawing from Deuteronomy 6:4–5 and Matthew 22:36–38, we'll see that love starts when our hearts are centered on Him. Until we learn to love God with all our heart, soul, and mind, we'll struggle to love anything or anyone else the way we're meant to.

**Week 2: Learning to Love Ourselves (the Right Way) (February 8)**

Next, we'll tackle a topic many of us find uncomfortable: loving ourselves. Using Psalm 139:13–18 and Matthew 22:39, we'll discover that the way we love our neighbor is deeply shaped by how we see ourselves.

**Week 3: Learning to Love One Another (February 15)**

In week three, we'll turn to John 13:34–35 and 1 Corinthians 13:1–7 to explore what it means to love one another within the body of Christ. Jesus calls us to a kind of love that looks like His—a love the world can recognize.

**Week 4: Learning to Love the Hard People (February 22)**

We'll conclude with perhaps the most challenging call: loving difficult people. Through Luke 6:27–36 and Romans 12:17–21, we'll see that this isn't weakness—it's Jesus' power at work in us.

Join us this February as we grow together in love!


