Each week in June, we'll explore a different Psalm and discover how it speaks into our everyday lives:

June 1 – "The Lord is My Shepherd" (Psalm 23)

Feeling a little lost or worn out? Psalm 23 is a reminder that God is guiding, protecting, and providing—every step of the way.

June 8 – "When Life is Overwhelming" (Psalm 46)

Let's face it: life gets heavy. This Psalm points us to the God who is our safe place, even when the world feels like it's shaking.

June 15 – "Create in Me a Clean Heart" (Psalm 51)

On Father's Day, we'll talk about second chances and fresh starts as we look at David's heartfelt prayer of repentance and renewal.

June 29 – "God's Word is a Lamp" (Psalm 119:105)


