As we continue our journey through *When God Shows Up: The Story That Leads to Jesus*, this month we come to several key moments in Genesis that reveal God's faithfulness and His plan to bring salvation through Christ.

We begin with Noah and the flood. In a world overwhelmed by sin, God brought judgment, yet He also provided a way of rescue through the ark. Noah's story reminds us that God is both just and merciful. Ultimately, the ark points us to Jesus, who is our true refuge and salvation.

Next, we visit the Tower of Babel, where human pride led people to seek greatness apart from God. The Lord humbled their efforts and scattered the nations. Yet God's plan was not defeated. Through Jesus, people from every nation and language are united as one family, accomplishing what humanity could never achieve on its own.

On Father's Day, we'll look at God's call of Abram in Genesis 12. God chose one man and one family through whom all the nations of the earth would be blessed. That promise finds its fulfillment in Jesus Christ, who opens the door of salvation to people everywhere.

We conclude the month in Genesis 15, where God establishes His covenant with Abram. In an extraordinary act of grace, God commits Himself to keeping His promises. This covenant points forward to the new covenant established through the blood of Jesus, securing our relationship with God through faith.

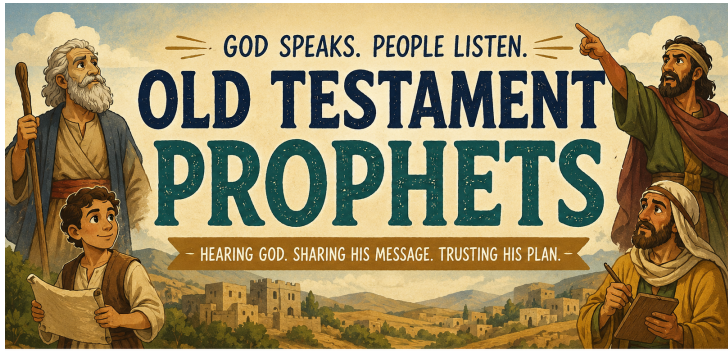

In this series, kids will discover how God used ordinary people—called prophets—to share His messages of love, warning, hope, and truth. From Isaiah to Jonah and others, we'll see how God called people from different backgrounds, gave them His words, and sent them to speak in challenging situations. 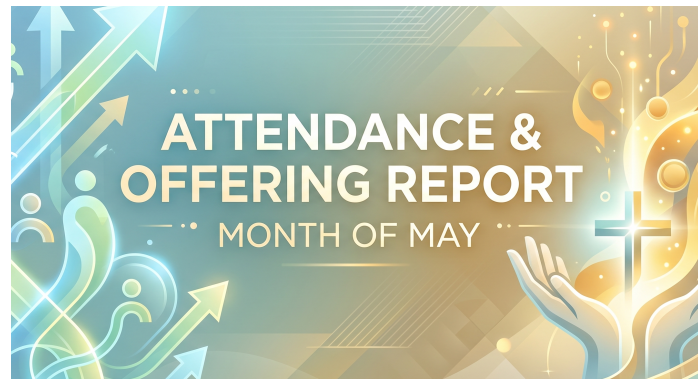
